



We have five senses and each sense has an organ:


- The organ of touch is the skin. We use our skin to identify hot or cold, hard or soft, smooth or rough.

- The organs of hearing are the ears. We use our ears to identify loud or quiet sounds.








The circulatory system




The respiratory system
